



CITY OF BOERNE

2020 RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLING SERVICE EXPLANATION

The City of Boerne has once-a-week pick up for trash and recycling, once-a-month pick up for bulk waste, and At Your Door Special CollectionSM for household hazardous waste (HHW) provided by Waste Management.

CARTS

Residents must use their existing 96-gallon green cart with a green lid for items considered trash.

Waste Management will deliver a NEW 64-gallon recycle cart the week of February 24, 2020. The NEW 64-gallon green cart with yellow lid is exclusively for items considered recycling.

Boerne residents are limited to two carts for trash collection, and one cart for recycling collection.

CURBSIDE TIMING

To ensure collection, carts must be at the curb no later than 7:00 AM on the scheduled collection day. You may set carts out after 5:00 PM on the day prior to scheduled collection. Carts must be removed by noon the day following collection. *Note: Collections may not occur at the same time of day each week.

CART PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- » Trash goes in the green cart with the green lid. All trash must be inside the cart. Waste Management will not collect trash outside the cart.
- » Recyclables go in the green cart with yellow lid. All recyclables must be LOOSE inside the cart. Waste Management will not collect recyclables outside the cart.
- » Do not overfill carts. Lids must close securely.
- » Place carts 5 feet from obstructions, such as vehicles or mailboxes, and within 1 foot from the curb or fence. Place carts 4 feet apart with the handles facing your home or fence.
- » Do not obstruct the collection of carts or bulk items by parking vehicles in the vicinity.

OBSERVED HOLIDAYS

Waste Management observes the following holidays, collection will not occur:

Thanksgiving, Christmas Day & New Year's Day

MISSED COLLECTION

Despite our best efforts, we occasionally miss scheduled collections. If we do, please call Waste Management at 800-800-5804 as soon as you can. We'll try to return on the same day to pick up your waste or recycling. If our driver has already left your area, we'll pick up what we missed the following day.

BULK COLLECTION

Bulk collection will be at the curb, once-a-month, with a limit of 4 cubic yards.

Bulk Waste

- » Carpeting (cut into 4 foot bundles)
- » Household furniture
- » Appliances with CFCs removed

NOT Bulk Waste

- » Appliances containing CFCs
- » Batteries
- » Concrete, brick, asphalt, and roofing
- » Construction debris from a contractor
- » Gasoline
- » Items heavier than 200 pounds
- » Paint
- » Motor oil and filters
- » Tires
- » Vehicles and parts

BRUSH

For the safety and protection of our employees and equipment, we require that branches and tree trimmings be no greater than five inches (5") in diameter, and be cut, tied, and bundled in five foot (5') lengths.

RECYCLING

- » Recyclables go in the green cart with the yellow lid.
- » Only place acceptable recyclables shown below in your recycling cart.
- » Containers should be rinsed and free of food and liquid.
- » Place recyclables loose inside the cart. Don't bag your recyclables.
- » Waste Management will collect recycling once-a-week.

Waste Management will collect the pesticides, household chemicals, sharps, electronic waste, batteries, fluorescent lamps, automotive waste products (including oil), paints, thinners, and dozens of other items that don't belong with your recyclables or regular curbside waste pickup.

Materials Accepted with Waste Management At Your DoorSM

Automotive Waste

Antifreeze, batteries, brake fluid, motor oil, filters, fuels

Garden Chemicals

Fertilizers, herbicides, insect sprays, pesticides, weed killers

Household Cleaners

Ammonia, heavy-duty cleaners, naval jelly, tile removers

Paint Products

Caulk, glue, paint, stripper, stain, thinner

Swimming Pool Chemicals

Chlorine tablets and liquid, pool acid, stabilizer

Household Waste

Artist's paint, CFL bulbs, electronics, sharps

Electronic Waste

PCs, MP3 players, iPods®, TVs, DVD players, cell phones, computers, monitors

MATERIAL THAT WILL NOT BE COLLECTED: Ammunition, medicine, explosives, asbestos, leaking containers, commercial chemicals, or hazardous materials in containers larger than five gallons.
